Tournament Rules & Regulations

Competition Format

- The tournament will follow a round robin format followed by a knockout phase which will determine the winning team in each category.
- Each game will consist of 2 x 10 minute halves
- All games are to start promptly on time.
- Each team is responsible for keeping track of the schedule and being on court ready to compete.
- Any delay of game may result in a forfeit
- The tournament/fixtures schedule will be made available 7 days prior to the event. This will be sent via email to each registering captain.
- Teams must have registered in person prior to 9:45 on the day of the event.
- If teams are tied on points at the end of the round robin, points difference will determine the teams finishing above. If these are tied, points scored will then be used followed by least points conceded.

The competition format and game times are subject to change depending on the number of teams entering. Registering teams will be made aware of any changes to the format/schedule.

Rules and Regulations

- All matches will be played in accordance with the International Netball Federation.
- Squad Sizes must be limited to 12 players.
- Officials for the event will be provided by Warwick Sport and will be possess either the International Netball Federation award or the C-Award in netball. For all teams competing on the day it is important to understand that officials will be volunteering their time to allow the event to run.

Refunds

Under no circumstances will refunds be provided unless the tournament is cancelled by Warwick Sport.

Tournament Kit

All teams are responsible for wearing matching kit with clearly displayed positions.

In the event of a colour clash, the team listed second on the completion schedule will be required to change kit or wear bibs.

Refreshments

Depending on the number of team entries Warwick Sport may be able to provide refreshments on the day of the event although this cannot be guaranteed. Registered captains will be kept updated on this prior to the event.

Teams are welcome to bring along their own food and drink for the event. Shops can be found a short drive away.

Changing Facilities

Shared changing facilities are available on site and close to the outdoor netball courts. Lockers are also available on site with £1.00 deposit per locker.

Warwick Sport will not accept responsibility for any items lost or stolen whilst on site.

First Aid

Teams will be responsible for their own first aid on the day of the event. St Johns Ambulance will be on site for the duration of the event to assist teams with additional first aid when required.

Parking

Limited parking for teams and spectators is available free of charge at the Cryfield Pavilion which is a short walk from the Sports and Wellness Hub where the Netball event will take place. A parking Permit must be obtained from within Cryfield Pavilion and clearly displayed in your car if you opt to park here. Failure to display a parking permit at Cryfield Pavilion may result in a fine.

Parking is available at the Sports and Wellness hub where the event will take place for the following prices:

Parking fees may be subject to change prior to the event. Registering captains will be kept up to date with any changes in car parking fees.
